

V-20 STEPLIFT

The V-20 Steplift's innovative stepped hull and classic lines have made her one of the best selling boats in her class for more than 20 years. It seems that quick planing ability, a super dry ride and superb stability never go out of style.

Her large, self-bailing cockpit has a no-nonsense layout that maximizes fishing room. Rod storage is plentiful under both gunwales and there are bait and fish boxes built right into the transom.



At the helm, there is a classic stainless steel destroyer-typewheel and a custom, swiveling bucket seat. A large, sliding hatch offers easy cabin access and ventilation, as well as providing easy access forward for anchor handling.

V-berth below so you can exercise your "fishing weekend" option more often. The cuddy is also great as a dry, lockable storage space when you're not aboard. But if the V-20's popularity over the last two decades is any indication, that won't be too often.
