

Pocket cruiser™ is a whole new class of boat, created when the first 233 Eclipse touched the water.

In addition to being a fine ski boat and day-runner, this all-around performer sleeps two in a large V-berth below deck. The cuddy also offers a dinette, galley with sink and an enclosed head. Add the optional canvas camper package and you have a topside stateroom for guests or the children.

The cockpit has been upgraded with molded foam seating, superior-grade vinyl and precision-detailed seams. The



new advanced dash is fully instrumented, has power steering and an AM/FM cassette player with premium water-resistant cockpit speakers. She also has amenities like coaming storage shelves with drink holders, cargo nets, a huge locker under the floor for gear, and a bow anchor locker.

The stern jump seats can be flipped up to form a sunpad on the stern and the top cushion on the new lightweight engine box lifts off for easy access. All-in-all, she's a very neat package from stem to stern.
