## 216 Eclipse & XL

With her chop-taming modified-V hull and power options up to 260 horsepower, the 216 Eclipse blurs the line between sport boat and performance boat.

Whichever way you look at her, you'll appreciate the new upgraded cockpit which includes sculptured seats made from molded, rather than cut, foam. The high-grade vinyl upholstery is backed with another

layer of foam for all-day comfort.

The dash features full instrumentation set in easy-reading recessed mounts, a padded steering wheel and an AM/FM cassette stereo with advanced, water-resistant speakers. The coaming shelves have molded-in coolie-can drink holders and innovative cargo nets underneath. Anchor storage is clean and convenient, thanks to a

locker on the bow.

A translucent deck hatch admits light to the spacious cuddy cabin, which features twin 6'8" V-berths and provisions for a head.

The XL version has all of this plus an aft sculptured sunpad, aft couch and swiveling bucket seats.
