The 3300 Coastal has become one of the most celebrated canyon runners in the highly competitive 30 to 40-foot range.

Her reputation as a serious offshore fishing machine is strongly reinforced by a huge, fully equipped cockpit. Nearly 13 feet of beam and a large transom door make her the match of any monster billfish.

The starboard utility box houses a prep station with a sink and optional recirculating bait-well. The portside box serves as a large storage area, or may be converted to an optional cockpit freezer. Twin, in-floor fish boxes are removable for easy cleaning; and rod storage in gunwale lockers is substantial.

Performance is equally impressive. She'll get you there and back at better than 30

knots with either the standard Mercruiser® 7.4 liter twins or optional CAT 3208TA's. And her shallow draft, prop pockets and heavy-duty underwater gear mean extra peace-of-mind when the water gets thin.

You'll find that she takes care of you just as well below as she does topside. The open, barrier-free interior layout maximizes living space and allows plenty of room for features like an entertainment center, full-size hanging locker, and optional overhead rod storage.

The galley has increased storage and counter space and features a large stainless steel sink and twin stove. There's even room for an optional microwave and coffeemaker.

There's also a fully enclosed private head with a translucent hatch, electric toilet, vanity, sink and shower. All standard.
